Willy Simon reported that the CMP is scoring projects for the Project Prioritization Process. The scores and MPO staff will make recommendations to the TCC.

Tab 4
R-19-01 MTB

Approval of UPWP Amendment for Federal Fiscal Years 2019 and 2020

Mr. Pennella reported that federal laws and regulations require an annual or biannual UPWP (Unified Planning Work Program) for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area that describes current transportation planning activities and those scheduled for the coming fiscal year. Originally, estimates of the planning funds expected to be available, as well as money for UPWP programs funded through other sources were included in the original UPWP document adopted by the MTB on June 15, 2018.

Upon conclusion of FFY 2018, actual carryover amounts were known and actual allocations of federal funding was provided by the USDOT through NMDOT. This resulted in a revised budget requiring this amendment.

The resolution takes the following actions:

- amends the UPWP for both FFY 2019 and FFY 2020
- authorizes the MPO Administrator and MRCOG Executive Director to submit the final UPWP to the NMDOT, the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration
- authorizes the execution of required contracts necessary to implement the UPWP.

Mr. Pennella explained that due to the inability to carry over State planning and research funds, \$32,000 which was needed for a new traffic counts van, was removed from SPR funds. The van purchase will be delayed until FFY 2020 if funds are available then at which time it will be added to the budget.

Mr. Pennella also said that, due to a typo, 530 Contract Services should be \$75k rather than \$175k. He noted that consultant contracts may have to be suspended until the government is again funded.

Mr. Pennella said that the MPO Administrator recommends adoption of the resolution and he stood for questions.

12 WHEREAS, the FFY 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is
13 the TIP for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area (AMPA) and has been
14 reviewed for conformity in conjunction with the 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan
15 and became effective October 1, 2017; and

16 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all federally-funded transportation projects in
17 the metropolitan transportation planning area prior to the distribution of funds to those
18 projects; and

19 WHEREAS, the TIP must contain all regionally significant projects in the
20 metropolitan transportation planning area regardless of the source of funding; and

21 WHEREAS, the TIP may be revised in accordance with Federal Regulations (23
22 CFR part 450.326),

23 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Metropolitan Transportation Board
24 of the Mid-Region Council of Governments of New Mexico that the FFY 2018-2023 TIP
25 for the Albuquerque Metropolitan Planning Area is revised to reflect the changes as set

26 out in ATTACHMENT A.

27 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Metropolitan Transportation Board, in
